Long-Range 1000 Yard Registered High Power Rifle Match 2010

DATES: July 17, 2010 Starting at 09:00 AM CST.

LOCATION: Hastings National Guard Camp, Hastings, Nebraska, the site is located approximately 2 miles east of the City of Hastings, Nebraska, along U.S. Highway 6 (South Street). Watch for signs. (HNGC GPS Coordinates 40.56960N, -98.27883W).

COMPETITION OPEN TO: Open to the public to anyone who can legally possess a firearm and to Juniors accompanied by an adult.

RULES : Current NRA High Power Long-Range Rules will apply.

REGISTRATION FEES: Individual / NRA fee: \$25.00 per competitor, juniors \$15.00

REGISTRATION AT THE RANGE. Range will open at 7:30am. Registration and match packets will be, behind the target berm on the KD Range, 7:30am to 8:30am. Squadding will end at 8:30am. There will be no food or sodas provided. Water and restrooms will be available.

ENTRIES - INDIVIDUAL: Entries in individual events will be made by using the SR-1 card, Entry and Score Reporting Card accompanied by payment. NRA members must record their NRA ID number. Circle the event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicate your current NRA Long-Range classification. Make checks payable to Eastern Nebraska Gun Club. Mail entries to Eugene Krepela 8013 Browne St. Omaha NE. 68134-2244. Individual entries must be received not later than Monday preceding the opening date of the tournament. Entries are limited to 16 competitors. Post entries will be accepted up to the stated limit of the range provided such entries will not require special relays.

The Chief Range Officer reserves the right to disqualify any unsafe rifle, ammunition, or competitor. Magnums are not allowed on this range, as they have the ability to exceed the safety impact area designed for this range.

TARGET OPERATION: Competitors will be responsible for target operation and scoring. Any substitutes must be cleared with the tournament match Director. Failure to comply will result in disqualification. *Hats, eye, and ear protection are highly recommended during pit relays.*

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$2.00 will be charged for each challenge made. See rule 16 for correct procedures.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA Long-Range and system will be used in all matches. Individuals who have not been classified will fire in the master class.

RIFLE: Equipment allowed will be in accordance with current NRA rules. Rifles allowed are Rifles allowed are NRA Match Rifle Rule 3.3 or 3.3.1, and 3.3.3, or Service Rifle Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.5 and 3.1.6

Compensators or muzzle brakes are prohibited (Rule 3.16.1). Empty chamber indicators are required

SIGHTING SHOTS: Unlimited sighting shots will be allowed for each match. When allowed they must be taken and scored.

TIME OF FIRING: Firing will commence at 09:00 AM CST.

COURSE OF FIRE:

Match 1 Any Sights One string of 20 shots for record prone with unlimited sighters slow fire. 30 minutes. LR 1000 yd target.

Match 2 Metallic Sights One string of 20 shots for record prone with unlimited sighters slow fire. 30 minutes. LR 1000 yd target.

Match 3 Aggregate of matches 1 and 2 for Match Winners aggregate 400.

AWARDS: Medals will be given for Match 1, 2, & 3 winners.
